Team Meeting

Members to travel to St Albans and meet at the RFS Shed. The recommended rout is via the Webbs Creek Ferry and St Albans Rd

Tasking

Our primary role is to provide a safety communications network on VHF Highband and operators for the event.

At control this will involve:

- 1. handing out radios to event staff (St Albans RFS staff, Checkpoint volunteers and medical staff, car parking staff);
- 2. monitoring the network and passing messages to event staff; and
- 3. recording time CREST personnel get to their locations.

At each of the checkpoints this will involve passing messages to control, other checkpoints or event staff.

Network

The network will consist of a Midband/UHF repeater hub and a Midband/UHF Cross band

Call signs

While mobile either going to/from your designated location or between locations use your CREST callsign. Upon arriving at your designated location you need to call in to say you are at your location and inform control that you will be using the callsign of the location.

Note: if there is more than one radio operator at the site then use the location with the word CREST on the end of your location.

Personal Equipment

Remember to bring:

- 1. chair;
- 2. paper and pen;
- 3. food and drink for the day;
- 4. clothing appropriate for the weather, i.e. warm, cool, rainwear; and sunscreen

Travel

Just before departing please let Des know your departure time either by SMS or radio if within range of the repeater. Upon arriving at your designated location please call in to control.

While travelling in convoy the VHF Highband CREST port 2s (old bandplan channel 22 or new bandplan channel 14) will be the preferred method of communications.

Upon arriving home please let Des know you are home and the time via SMS.
